Shower Power is a ministry in downtown Jackson, Ms. Shower Power is more than a shower! They bring hospitality to the streets by delivering mobile hygiene services to people experiencing homelessness. They have given well over 3,500 showers to people in need, and fed, fellowshipped, and ministered to as many as a few hundred unique visitors. Food, basic necessities, clothing items, and hygiene items, are provided as well. It's all about taking time to show people that you care and restoring dignity by providing resources needed for self-care.
